Winning student cake entries will also win points for their House and will be ranked as follows:

- 1st place – 100 points
- 2nd place – 90 points
- 3rd place – 80 points
- 4th place – 70 points
- 5th place – 60 points

All entries must be submitted via your student UKAT email to the following email address: CGcompetitions@universityofkentacademiustrust.org.uk by **Friday 16th February 2024**. The winner will be announced on **Thursday 22nd February 2024**. The competition opens on **1st February 2024**.

Important Information:

1. If you win, you will receive an email via your student UKAT email to notify you. We will then arrange emailing you your Amazon voucher.
2. House points will be announced during Personal Tutoring and will be included in the end of Term 4 points.
3. Please ask a **parent or carer's** permission before submitting your entry.
4. You can only **enter** the competition by sharing your photo and recipe of your entry to: CGcompetitions@universityofkentacademiustrust.org.uk and can **only do so** through your **UKAT email**. Any entries received via a personal account will be discounted.
5. You must be a **current student** to enter the competition.
6. **All year groups** can enter this competition with **one entry per person**.
7. Entries open on the 1st February 2024. You must submit your entry by **Friday 16th February 2024**. Any entries after this deadline will be discounted.
8. The content of your entry must be of an **appropriate nature**. If your entry is deemed inappropriate, it will be discounted.
9. To create your cake/cupcakes, you may use a range of ingredients and/or materials/equipment. However, please ensure you are **supervised by a parent or carer when using cooking equipment and appliances**.

10. It is **your responsibility** to ensure that the entry you **submit is your own**, or if it does belong to someone else, that you **seek their permission** before submitting. We will not take any responsibility for entries that infringe **copyright legislation**.
11. Ensure you apply safe searching if looking for inspiration for your submission online. You can visit the National Online Safety social media website for useful information on safe searching: <https://nationalonlinesafety.com/>.
12. By entering this competition, you give us permission to post your entry on our social media platforms (Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram). The only information that will be **shared online** is your **forename** or **chosen initials** and **year group**. When entering, please specify all relevant information. If you do **not want your entry to be shared online**, you must specify this when entering.
13. Once your entry has been **submitted**, you cannot change it. You may ask for your entry to be removed from the competition, but in doing so, means you cannot re-enter either.
