Seacole Charity Day, Monday 3rd October

Students in Seacole House are preparing a day of fundraising events for Seacole Charity Day, which will be held on Monday 3rd October.

As part of this day of fundraising, students will have the opportunity to purchase items from a tuck shop and bake sale, enter an art competition and participate in a Halloween-themed movie night at the end of the academy day. As well as this, we will have a Tag Day - students are encouraged to dress as something that begins with the same first letter as their name, or alternatively wear something yellow, the colour of Seacole House. We are asking for a £1 donation for students to participate in the Tag Day.

Students who wish to participate in the movie night will need to collect a permission slip from H7, and this must be signed by a parent or carer and returned to myself by Friday 30th September. Again, we are asking for a £1 donation on the door for the movie night, and all proceeds raised on this day will be donated to Links Across Borders, a charity which we will be fundraising for throughout the year at the academy.

The charity:

- Co-create libraries in collaboration with stake-holders and beneficiary communities in Ghana.
- Facilitate training programs, and empowerment projects to build community economic capacity.
- Support Teacher Capacity promotion through workshops, seminars, and material resources.
- Support and facilitate Girl Empowerment programs.
- Coordinate various international visitors (Group and Individual) programs to promote cultural diversity, and education.
- Provide international (global) and local (Ghanaian) internship and placement opportunities for college and university students.

Please note that all fundraising will happen before and after the academy day, as well as during break times, so students should be prepared to attend their lessons as usual.
